



Spanish Intensive Course in Munich

Curso Intensivo de Español en Múnich

As the international language of business, English is today a basic requirement for all students; however, students at the Munich Business School are also required to have a second foreign language. Students who do not possess adequate linguistic skills in a second foreign language may acquire the necessary skills for their studies by attending the Spanish Intensive Course.

Spanish is the official language in 21 countries and spoken by approximately 400 million people around the world. Spanish is the third-most spoken language in the world after Chinese and English, and the second-most important business language in the world.

The Spanish Intensive Course at the Munich Business School will consist of a total of 100 periods to be held over four weeks before the start of the semester. Students will partake in an intensive and interactive course, working in small groups of 8 to a maximum of 12 participants, thus allowing them to achieve rapid learning success. Thereby, students will focus on improving listening and reading comprehension, as well as oral and written expression. Modern teaching methods and a sociocultural program ensure an intensive and interesting entry to the language. The objective of the course is to achieve level A2 language skills in accordance with the directives of the Council of Europe.

All lecturers are qualified native speakers and possess extensive practical experience. They also all teach within the regular academic program of the Munich Business School.

The course shall end with a certificate from the Munich Business School. The certificate acknowledges that the student possesses the necessary Spanish skills to be admitted to the Bachelor program at the MBS.

Criterios de evaluación:

Al finalizar el curso, el alumno es capaz de:

- Hacer preguntas a terceras personas sobre la información personal de las mismas

- Presentarse ante terceras personas
- Describirse a sí mismo y terceras personas (descripción de físico y carácter)
- Explicar por qué quiere aprender español

- Describir la rutina diaria de su persona
- Hablar sobre las actividades del tiempo libre que le gusta practicar
